

# Baby Anchor Cardigan

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Difficulty Level: ★★☆☆☆

Size: 12 month

Finished Measurements: 22 inches

Materials: Worsted Weight yarn In light gray and dark gray, size 6 (U.S.) and 8(U.S.)  
knitting needles; cable needle; six 5/8-inch buttons.

Gauge: 4 ½ sts/inch on larger needles and stockinette stitch

Abbreviations:

K1-b: knit into the back of the stitch

P1-b: purl into the back of the stitch

Kfb: Knit into the front and the back of next stitch

Pfb: purl into the front and back of the next stitch

C4F: Slip next 2 sts to cable needle and hold in front; k2, then k2 from cable needle.

C4B: Slip next 2 sts to cable needle and hold in back; k2, then k2 from cable needle.

Sl 1-k2tog-pssso: Slip next st knitwise, k2tog, then pass slipped st over.

Directions:

Back: With size 6 needles and dark gray, cast on 59 sts.

Row 1: k2, (p2, k2) across to last st, k1.

Row 2: k1, p2, (k2, p2) across.

Repeat rows 1 and 2 three more times.

Change to size 8 needles and light gray.

Decreasing 3 sts evenly across 1<sup>st</sup> row only, work in stockinette stitch until piece measures 6 inches. End by working a wrong side row. (56 sts).

Shape Armholes:

Row 1: Bind off 5 sts, knit to end.

Row 2: Bind off 10 sts, purl to end.

Row 3: Ssk, knit to last two sts, k2tog.

Row 4: Purl

Row 5: knit

Row 6: purl.

Row 7: Ssk, knit to last two sts, k2tog.

Row 8: Purl.

Repeat rows 7 and 8 until there are 19 sts left on needle. End by working row 8. Bind off.

Front:

With size 6 needles and dark gray, cast on 47 sts.

Row 1: k1, (k2, p2) across to last 2 sts, k2.

Row 2: p2, (k2, p2) across to last st, k1.

Repeat rows 1 and 2 three more times.

Change to size 8 needles and dark gray.

Decreasing 1 st at center of 1<sup>st</sup> row only, begin working in stockinette st for 11 rows. (46 sts).

Row 11 (wrong side): p15, k21, p10.

Row 12: knit

Row 13: repeat row 11.  
Row 14: k11, kfb, k17, kfb, k16. (48 sts)  
Row 15: p19, k15, p14.  
Row 16: k10, C4B, p15, C4F, k15.  
Row 17: rep row 15  
Row 18: k14, p7, (k1, yo, k1) in next st, p7, k19. (50 sts)  
Row 19: p19, k6, slip next st to cable needle and hold in front, p1-b, then k1 from cable needle, pfb, slip next st to cable needle and hold in back, k1, then p1-b from cable needle, k6, p14. (51 sts)  
Row 20: k10, C4B, p5, slip next st to cable needle and hold in back, k1-b, then p1 from cable needle, p1, Tw2R, p1, slip next st to cable needle and hold in front, p1, then k1-b from cable needle, p5, C4F, k15.  
Row 21: p19, k4, slip next st to cable needle and hold in front, p1-b, then k1 from cable needle, k2, p2, k2, slip next st to cable needle and hold in back, k1, then p1-b from cable needle, k4, p14.  
Row 22: k14, p3, slip next st to cable needle and hold in back, k1-b, then p1 from cable needle, p3, Tw2R, p3, slip next st to cable needle and hold in front, p1, then k1-b from cable needle, p3, k19.  
Row 23: p19, k2, p3, k3, p2, k3, p3, k2, p14.  
Row 24: k10, C4B, p2, sl1-k2tog-ssso, p3, Tw2R, p3, sl1-k2tog-ssso, p2, C4F, k15. (47 sts)  
Row 25: p19, k2, pfb, k3, p2, k3, pfb, k2, p14. (49 sts)  
Row 26: k14, p7, Tw2R, p7, k19.  
Row 27: p19, k7, p2, k7, p14.  
Row 28: k10, C4B, p7, Tw2R, p7, C4F, k15.  
Row 29: rep row 27.  
Row 30: k14, p4, k8, p4, k19.  
Row 31: Bind off 5 sts, p13, k4, p8, k4, p14. (44 sts)  
Row 32: k1, ssk, k7, C4B, p7, Tw2R, p7, C4F, k7, k2tog, k1. (42 sts)  
Row 33: p13, k7, p2, k7, p13.  
Row 34: k13, p7, k1, yo, k1, p7, k13. (43 sts)  
Row 35: p13, k7, p3, k7, p13.  
Row 36: k1, ssk, k6, C4B, p7, sl1-k2tog-ssso, p7, C4F, k6, k2tog, k1. (39 sts)  
Row 37: p12, k15, p12.  
Row 38: k1, ssk, k9, p15, k9, k2tog, k1. (37 sts)  
Row 39: p11, k15, p11.  
Row 40: k1, ssk, k4, C4B, p15, C4F, k4, k2tog, k1. (35 sts)  
Row 41: p6, k1, k2tog, k17, k2tog, k1, p6. (33 sts)  
Row 42: k1, ssk, k27, k2tog, k1. (31 sts)  
Row 43: p5, k21, p5.  
Row 44: k1, ssk, knit to last 3 sts, k2tog, k1. (29 sts)

Row 45: purl.

Row 46: rep row 44. (27 sts)

Row 47: purl.

Continuing to shape raglan armholes as set, bind off center 11 sts. Working each side separately, also dec 1 st at neck edge every right side row until only 1 st remains. Fasten off.

Sleeves:

With size 6 needles and dark gray, cast on 30 sts.

Row 1: k2, (p2, k2) across.

Row 2: p2, (k2, p2) across.

Repeat rows 1 and 2 three more times.

Change to larger needles and light gray. Work in stockinette stitch, increasing 1 st each side of 4<sup>th</sup> row, and then every 6<sup>th</sup> row until there are 42 sts on needle. Work even until sleeve measures 8 inches.

Shape Armholes:

Row 1: Bind off 5 sts, knit to end.

Row 2: Bind off 5 sts, purl to end.

Row 3: Ssk, knit to last two sts, k2tog.

Row 4: Purl

Row 5: knit

Row 6: purl.

Row 7: Ssk, knit to last two sts, k2tog.

Row 8: Purl.

Repeat rows 7 and 8 until there are 10 sts left on needle. End by working row 8. Bind off.

Sew Sleeve seams. Sew Right Sleeve to Right Front and Right Back at raglan seams and underarm. Sew Left Sleeve to Left Back, and sew underarm seam, leaving Front raglan edge free.

Buttonhole Band:

With size 6 needles and dark gray, pick up 56 sts evenly along Front edge and raglan.

Row 1: k1, (p2, k2) across to last 3 sts, p1, k1.

Row 2: k1, (k2, p2) across to last 3 sts k3.

Rows 1 and 2 set 2x2 rib.

Row 3 (Buttonhole Row): Rib 8, yo, k2tog, (rib 9, yo, k2tog) more times, rib to end.

Rows 4-6: rib as set

Bind off in rib.

Button Band:

With size 6 needles, and dark gray, pick up 56 sts evenly along Left Sleeve raglan and down side of Left Back.

Row 1: k1, (p2, k2) across to last 3 sts, p1, k1.

Row 2: k1, (k2, p2) across to last 3 sts k3.

Rows 1 and 2 set 2x2 rib.

Rows 3-6: Rib as set

Bind off in rib.

Neckband:

With Size 6 needles and dark gray, pick up 5 sts along edge of Buttonhole band, 22 sts along Front neck, 8 sts along Right Sleeve, 16 sts along Back, 8 sts along Left Sleeve, and 5 sts along edge of Button band. (64 sts)

Row 1: k1, (p2, k2) across to last 3 sts, p1, k1.

Row 2: k1, (k2, p2) across to last 3 sts k3.

Rows 1 and 2 set 2x2 rib.

Row 3: Rib to last 3 sts, yo, p2tog (buttonhole made), k1.

Rows 4-6: Rib as set

Bind off in rib.

Sew Buttons under buttonholes.
