Feather and Fan Tee

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Difficulty Level ★★☆☆☆

Size: Women's Medium (to fit a 36"

chest)

Finished Measurement: 35 inches (negative ease for a close fit to

open up the lace)

Materials:

Size 9 (U.S.) knitting needles; 16 inch circular knitting needle, size 6 (U.S.); 1 skein Red Heart Baby Econo (white); four (50 gm) balls Nocturne) or similar Aran weight yarn to obtain gauge; stitch marker.

Gauge: 1 pattern repeat (18 sts) = 4 %

inches

Directions:

Back:

With larger needles and purple, Cast on 74 sts.

Row 1: knit across.

Row 2: purl across.

Row 3: k1, *(k2tog) 3x, (yo, k1)6x, (k2tog) 3x, rep from * across to last 1 st; k1.

Row 4: rep row 2.

Rows 5 and 6: with White, knit across.

Repeat rows 1-6 for pattern.

Work in set patt until piece measures approximately 23 inches, ending with row 4. Bind off knitwise on right side

Front:

Work same as Back until piece measures 20 inches.

Bind off center 28 sts.

Working each side separately, and working in established patt, dec 1 st at neck edge on next 3 rows. (20 sts each side).

Work even until piece measures same as back, ending with row 4. Bind off knitwise on right side.



Sleeves (make two):

Work same as Back for three repeats of pattern, ending last repeat by working row 4. Bind off knitwise on right side.

Finishing:

Sew shoulder seams. Sew sleeves onto edges of body, matching center of sleeve to shoulder seam. Sew sleeve and body seams.

With circular needle and White, pick up 94 sts evenly around neck, starting at one shoulder seam. Place marker to mark beginning of round.

Round 1: Purl Round 2: knit Bind off loosely purlwise.

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
